We contribute to UNIFIL and help strengthening the LAF

- **Contribution to the UNIFIL Maritime Task Force since 2006 (since 2021 under German command):** safeguarding maritime borders, preventing smuggling activities.
- **Support to the LAF with a focus on maritime projects:** training at the Naval Equipment & Training Centre in Jounieh, facilitating radar stations, a control center to monitor territorial waters, medical equipment, fuel supply, sustainable energy.
